Role 1: Bike Valet

Objectives

- To facilitate and monitor Bike Valet, our free bicycle drop-off service

Responsibilities:

- Administer Bike Valet bands to those using the service
- Guide bicyclists to using the bike rack
- Monitor the bike racks to ensure the security of each and every bike/scooter/wagon
- Keep tally of the number of bikes checked in
- Confirm bike tag number matches the wristband number on each bike as they are recollected by owners

Time Commitment:

Skills/Qualifications

- Comfortable speaking with authority

Role 2: Bouncer Supervisor

Objectives

- To supervise children on the inflatable bouncers

Responsibilities:

- Monitor children using the inflatable bouncers in the kid zone
- Ensure safety of children
- Reduce horseplay on the bouncers if necessary

Role 3: Bar Back

Objectives

- To transport beer, cider, and wine into the alcohol sales area and removing empties/boxes

Responsibilities:

- Transport cases of beer, cider and wine from the outdoor cooler into the bar area within the Summerfest area
- Restock coolers and move empty cases, empty bottles, and empty cans from behind the bar as needed

Time Commitment:

- Available shifts listed in email

Skills/Qualifications

- SMART Serve Certification
- Must be 18+
- Able to lift 30lb+

Role 4: Server

Objectives

- To serve beer, cider, or wine at Summerfest

Responsibilities:

- Serve beer, cider, or wine to customers
- Accept alcohol tickets in the appropriate bin
- Pour the appropriate/standardized serving of alcohol per ticket
- Recognize when to cut someone off
- Practice SMART Serve principles

Time Commitment:

- Available shifts listed in email

Skills/Qualifications

- Valid SMART Serve Certificate required for serving
- Must be 18+ to serve alcohol

Role 7: Golf Attendant

Objectives

- Stationed Saturday on the street and Sunday at Peace Park, the golf attendant will hand out necessary equipment and ensure equipment is being used properly.
